

# Bachelor of Arts

## Major in Sociology Degree Requirements

- 1. Hours for Degree:** Completion of a minimum of 124 semester hours, 42 of which must be advanced.
- 2. General University Requirements:** See "General University Requirements" in the Academic section of this catalog.
- 3. University Core Curriculum:** Minimum 47 hours. See specific degree plan for exact hours.
- 4. Major Requirements:**
  - Required courses include: SOCI 1510, 3050, 4000, 4880 plus 18 additional hours in sociology of which 12 must be taken at UNT and at the advanced level (3000 or 4000).
  - Recommended courses include: SOCI 1520, 2010, 3000, 3300, 3330, 4160 and/or 4340.
- 5. Other Requirements:**
  - A total of 42 hours upper division work (advanced courses).
  - 31 hour residence requirement (24 of the last 30 hours must be completed at UNT).

Maximum of 36 hours of correspondence, extension, credit by examination and/or military service credit is allowed toward degree.

*DRED* (Traffic Safety) courses may not be used to satisfy any portion of a degree in sociology.
