The Provost Meeting

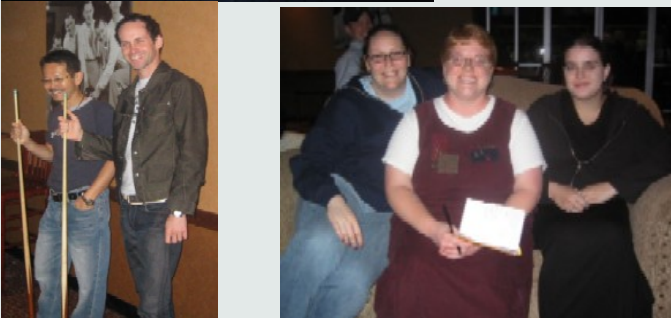

Upcoming APA Deadline

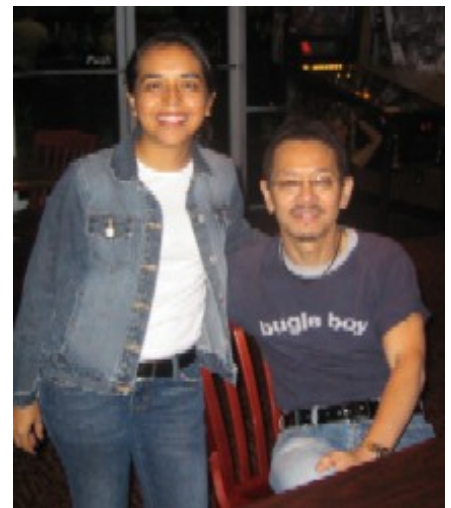
