## **INITIAL HEARING** **EXPLANATION OF PROCEDURE**

You have been requested to come to the Office of the Center for Student Rights and Responsibilities to assist in the investigation of alleged misconduct. As the Judicial official, I will review the nature of the complaint and the relevant evidence or testimony with you. At that point, I will give you an opportunity to respond and will ask questions pertinent to the allegations. You will be given ample opportunity to speak and to tell me anything you want to tell me.

This is a hearing to ascertain the facts of the complaint. Your cooperation by providing truthful answers to questions is not only necessary but expected, in accordance with the Code of Student Conduct. Notes of the information you give and anything you say may be used in disciplinary proceedings. You may be asked to sign a copy of the statements you make or to provide a written account of the information you give me.

The university policies which impact student behavior are educational in nature. They are published for student use and are designed to help students understand and accept responsibility for their own actions. In the event that behavioral sanctions against you should be deemed to be appropriate following the conclusion of this investigation, you will be given a copy of these policies, along with the procedures for appeal.
