On Monday, December 10th from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm (lunch provided), they will meet with experts on RFID and asset management from the U.S. in a forum hosted by the Information Systems Research Center (ISRC, Director, Dr. Chang E Koh) to discuss various topics and issues associated with implementing RFID in asset management in a university setting. Each expert will introduce him/herself and make a short presentation for 15 minutes or less with follow-up Q&A and discussion.

Some of the questions that the Koreans are interested in discussing at the forum include:

- How does your university (organization) manage properties?
- What is the size or scope of asset items that your organization currently track and manage?
- Does your organization use RFID for asset management?
- To what extent universities in the U.S. have adopted RFID for managing assets?
- What's your opinion about the use of RFID in asset management for universities?
- How does your organization utilize RFID?
- What are the pros and cons of using RFID for asset tracking and management?
- What's your assessment of the current state of RFID and its future?
