ENTRIES ACCEPTED: August 31 – September 15

ENTRY FEE: \$45 per league team/\$25 per pre-season team

PRE-SEASON TOURNAMENT DATE: Thursday, September 17

LEAGUE START DATE: Monday, September 21

MANDATORY CAPTAINS MEETING: Wednesday, September 16, 5:00 PM, Pohl Recreation Center 205. Each team must have a representative present.

FREE AGENTS MEETING: Tuesday, September 15 @ 4:30 PM in Pohl Recreation Center 203

DIVISIONS: Men's, Women's, & Co-Rec

PRE-SEASON TOURNAMENT FORMAT: The tournament format will be based on the number of entries for that sport.

LEAGUE FORMAT: Leagues will be set up in a round robin format. The leagues will last approximately four weeks with one additional week for the playoffs. The playoff format will be a single elimination tournament.

LOCATION OF PLAY: All games will be played at the Intramural Fields, the Recreational Sports Complex, the Eagle Point Intramural Rec Sports Fields, or Traditions Fields.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: In case of inclement weather, information concerning the status of the games will be available by calling the **24-hour Recreational Sports Information Line, 369-7100**. Updated information will be provided as it becomes available.

SCHEDULES: Pre-Season Tournament and league schedules will be ready for team captains at the captains meeting. Playoff schedules will be available at the playoff captains meeting. That meeting date and time will be determined at a later date.

EQUIPMENT: Game balls will be provided for all games or teams may choose to provide their own ball. Footballs may be checked out from the game sites with a valid ID card.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Any male or female student currently enrolled in the University with an active Pohl Recreation Center Membership is eligible to participate. Faculty and Staff who are members of the Pohl Recreation Center are also eligible to participate. You must have your ID with you to be eligible to play.
2. Individuals may play on one single sex team and one co-rec team. A player must finish the season with the same team that they started the season with. For instance, if you play on a Men's A team, you can't play on another Men's A team or any other men's team at all.
3. Each participant is responsible for knowing all the information in the Recreational Sports Calendar for Intramural participation. This information is available on the Recreational Sports website, the Recreational Sports Calendar, or in Pohl Recreation Center 103.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

1. Rosters and entry fees are due in the Recreational Sports office, located in the Pohl Recreation Center room 103 by 6:00 PM on **Tuesday, September 15**. The entry fee for each team must accompany the roster in order for the team to be accepted. Captains are required to attend the captains meeting on **Wednesday, September 16 at 5:00 PM**. The purpose of this meeting is to distribute schedules and discuss any necessary rules.
2. Rosters are unlimited. Teams may carry as many members as they like, but awards are limited to fourteen (14) per team.
3. Teams need to list a captain and an alternate captain. These two people should not live in the same house, have the same phone number, or be the same person. The alternate captain is just another way for the Recreational Sports office to contact a team if the need should arise. It is very important that the information on the captain and the alternate captain be as accurate as possible. If the phone number is not correct, then we can't get in touch with you.
4. It is important that you fill out the entry form completely. If not, then your team could be placed in a time slot or on a day that is not convenient for your team.
