TOURNAMENT START DATE: Thursday, October 1

MANDATORY PLAYERS MEETING: Thursday, October 1, 4:30 PM, at the Waranch Tennis Complex. Each participant must be present.

DIVISIONS: Men's, Women's, & Co-Rec

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Leagues will be set up in a single elimination format.

LOCATION OF PLAY: All games will be played at the Waranch tennis courts.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: In case of inclement weather, information concerning the status of the tournament games will be available by calling the **24-hour Recreational Sports Information Line, 369-7100**. Updated information will be provided as it becomes available.

SCHEDULES: Tournament schedules will be ready for players at the **Mandatory** players meeting on **Thursday, October 1st**.

EQUIPMENT: the participants must provide game balls.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Any male or female student currently enrolled in the University with an active Pohl Recreation Center Membership is eligible to participate. Faculty and Staff who are members of the Pohl Recreation Center are also eligible to participate. You must have your ID with you to be eligible to play.
2. Each participant is responsible for knowing all the information in the guidelines for Intramural participation. This information is available on the Recreational Sports website (www.unt.edu/recsports) or in POHL RECREATION CENTER 103.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

1. Players must sign up in the Recreational Sports office, located in the POHL RECREATION CENTER room 103, by 5:00 PM on **Tuesday, September 29**. There is no entry fee for this sport. Players are required to attend the players meeting on **Thursday, October 1** at 4:30 PM. The purpose of this meeting is to distribute schedules and discuss any necessary rules.

RULES OF PLAY

The official rules of the United States Tennis Association (USTA) will be the guidelines for play with the following exceptions:

1. All players must provide their own tennis balls.
2. All players must be present and ready to play at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled match time.
3. To win a match, players must win 2 out of 3 sets. To win a set a player must win 6 games in that set. Advantage scoring will be used in all three sets. A 12-point tiebreaker will be used in all 3 sets.
4. Players must report the scores to the supervisor on duty. Failure to report scores will result in a double forfeit for that match.
