New terminal course recently created officially begins Fall 2009 Catalog: MATH 1080

University Core (Math) options: choose one from MATH 1080, 1100, 1680 or higher

MATH 1010 is pre-requisite to 1080 and 1100. MATH Placement Testing is required for all MATH courses at UNT.

- MATH 1680 is no longer considered a pre-requisite for any of the higher math courses. College Algebra should be recommended to any student who may be considering a degree that will require any math other than terminal (one) course for university core curriculum.

**II: STUDENT MONEY MANAGEMENT CENTER (Paul Goebel)**

Paul presented a group activity where advisors considered several typical student scenarios regarding finances and discussed appropriate suggestions for each. Discussion of student memorial loans as one option available to UNT students.

**III: SFAS – Student Financial Aid Services (Lacey Thompson) – AskUNT**
