
What is the Student Financial Obligation?

When you initially register as a student at the University of North Texas, you establish a student account with the University through Student Financial Services. As part of establishing a student account, all students are required to review and complete the Student Financial Obligation. The Student Financial Obligation is a statement of the terms and conditions of the student account.


How do students complete the Student Financial Obligation in MyUNT?

The Student Financial Obligation is presented to a student as a hold on their account within MyUNT (my.unt.edu). The steps below outline the process for completing the Student Financial Obligation.


Step 1: Log into your MyUNT account with your EUID username and password.




Step 2: Click the red action message showing the number of holds on your account.



Step 3: Select the "Remove Hold" option next to the Student Financial Obligation hold.



Step 4: Review the Financial Terms and Conditions and scroll to end of the page.



<u>Step 5:</u> Click "Confirm" at the end of the page once you have read through the information and your hold will be removed automatically.
